

Author guidelines for proceedings

Proceedings of the 4th National Editors Conference, comprising full papers, will be produced.

Selected papers will be published on the IPEd website (<http://www.iped-editors.org>) as soon as possible after the conference ends.

Submission requirements

- All papers must be submitted in Microsoft Word 2003-compatible format.
- Papers should be a maximum length of 5000 words.
- Please email a copy of your paper to the program committee chair, Loene Doube, at loene@adelaide.on.net by Friday 30 October 2009 if you wish it to be considered for publication on the IPEd website.

All authors' names, affiliations and email contact details must be supplied on the paper.

Papers should follow the style conventions of the *Style manual for authors, editors and printers* (6th edition, 2002, John Wiley & Sons Australia) and should use its recommended style for author–date citation.

Because papers will be loaded on the IPEd website as pdf documents, authors may use their preferred font and formatting.
